Instant Noodles Donated to Quake-hit Iran & Iraq

World Instant Noodles Association (WINA) has supplied 100,000 servings of instant noodles as emergency rations to the stricken region of a 7.3-magnitude earthquake occurred on November 12th around the border of Iran & Iraq via the Red Crescent Societies. This is a joint relief effort with Nissin Yildiz (Managing Director: Hidefumi Kawakita), a WINA member company in Turkey. Furthermore, Nissin Yildiz provided 40,000 servings of instant noodles separately from the joint relief with WINA as part of the company's own relief efforts. 140,000 servings of instant noodles in total were distributed as emergency foods to the affected areas.
