550,000 instant noodles donated to Quake-hit China's Qinghai

World Instant Noodles Association donated instant noodles as emergency ration to the victims suffered from the great earthquake in Qinghai Province in China, occurred on April 14. In order to respond swiftly to the food shortage in the quake-hit area, China based WINA members, have shipped out a total of about 550,000 packages of instant noodles.

World Instant Noodles Association was founded in 1997, with the purpose to improve the quality of instant noodle products, to promote the consumption increase and the industry's development, and to contribute to a diet for people all over the world. At the 6th World Instant Noodles Summit Osaka held in 2008, the association established "WINA Disaster Relief Fund" using donation from late Momofuku Ando (Founder of Nissin Food Products). This is the seventh time the fund is used, following the quake in Haiti early this year.
