10,000 instant noodles donated to Flood-hit Northern Hungary

World Instant Noodles Association donated instant noodles as emergency ration to the victims suffered from the flood in Northern Hungary, occurred in early June. In order to respond swiftly to the food shortage in the flood-hit area, Nissin Foods Kft.(Managing Director: Osamu Tetsubayashi), a Hungary-based WINA member, supplied about 10,000 packages of instant noodles to the city of Edeleny.

World Instant Noodles Association was founded in 1997, with the purpose to improve the quality of instant noodle products, to promote the consumption increase and the industry's development, and to contribute to a diet for people all over the world. At the 6th World Instant Noodles Summit Osaka held in 2008, the association established "WINA Disaster Relief Fund" using donation from late Momofuku Ando (Founder of Nissin Food Products). This is the eighth time the fund is used, following the quake in China's Qinghai in April.
