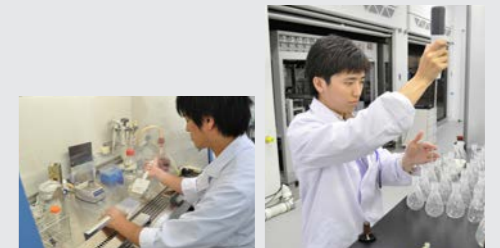
## Business Program:

# WINA Funds

## WINA Food Safety Research Fund

We offer WINA Food Safety Inspection Service for WINA members to ensure food safety and improve the quality of instant noodles. WINA Food Safety Research Fund covers a half of the fee for the analysis of hazardous substances.



## WINA Disaster Relief Fund

We provide instant noodles in aid to the victims of natural disasters that occur all over the world. Since WINA Disaster Relief Fund was established in 2008, we have provided more than 5.8 million servings of instant noodles as emergency rations for a total of 25 devastating disasters (as of October 2017 ).
